On the same programme we have the Microsprints racing for points in their Victorian Series, the Dirt Go Karts having demonstration runs and finishing the night off with the hilarious Figure 8 Jump Race, a great night for the whole family!

Our biggest race meeting for the year goes under the green flag on January 20<sup>th</sup> with the running of the Kings Sprintcar Challenge with all of Australia's and America's best here to see who can be crowned King of Borderline for 2012. On the same night are the Street Stocks and the ever popular V8 SuperRods, after a few years absence these guys are keen to get back here and put on some awesome racing for the crowd.

Racing returns on March 17<sup>th</sup> with round 4 of the MJS Series for Street Stocks with a cool grand to the winner, also our only State Title for this season will be run when the Limited Sportsman battle it out to see who can be the states number 1 driver.
